Junior WA18m - for ages Under 21; under 16 and under 12, subject to entries



Senior Compound archers will shoot on individual 40cm 3-spot faces. (U 21 Compound archers please note on entry form if would prefer to shoot on a 40cm 3-spot face). All other archers on individual 40cm full face

There will be 4 archers per target shooting in 2 details. 3 arrows will be shot in two minutes, controlled by Danage timers. Shot to WA Rules. Compound archers will shoot on foam bosses all other archers will shoot on straw bosses.

Equipment Inspection will take place prior to practice.

Note: When you enter the competition, the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists, and results may be published showing first names, surname, gender, bow style, date of birth/age category, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round, Disabled (Y/N), Disability Info. By signing the entry form you are agreeing to this.

Drug Testing Record status shoots will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply.

A refusal will be treated as a positive result.

Dress Archers must comply with Archery GB rule 307.

Notes Please wear soft non-marking shoes in the sports hall. The Hall is heated but not over warm.

Shooting will take place in Hall 1 (access via first entrance from the car park)
