## DCAS JUNIOR FUND



The Junior Fund exists for the benefit of our Junior archers by way of grants, funding entry to certain shoots and interest-free equipment Loans.

The Fund is financed by the annual Individual Junior Fees paid to County (currently £3.00 per head) and any surpluses from Junior coaching events and/or Junior squad training.

## **Application of Fund**

- 1. 1. Discretionary funding of Coaching/Squad Training for Junior archers at County/Regional level considered by the Executive & Junior Rep without the need for any applications.
- 2. Discretionary Grants may be made to any Junior Archer in DCAS for:
- a) **Travel & Accommodation:** Up to 20% towards travelling and accommodation expenses when selected to represent the County, Region or Country.
- b) Up to 20% towards National Squad Training / Development Coaching costs.
- c) **Purchase of Equipment:** by advancing an interest-free loan (up to £400), repayable by Standing Order over a period not exceeding 12 months.

## Limits on grants within 2a) and 2b)

- UK events/shoots: Up to £50 per event; £200 max grants in any financial year
- International events/shoots: Up to £100 per event; £250 max grants in any financial year All requests for funding, either grant or loan within item 2 above, should be made in writing to the DCAS Junior Representative.

## 3. Free Entry to:

- a) Any/all DCAS-organised County shoots (recharged from the County Tournament Organiser's account). Done automatically no application necessary.
- DCAS Indoor Champs (restricted to "free" entry to one session only)
- DCAS Grand Day
- DCAS day at Exmouth July Dbl WA1440
- DCAS day at Redruth August Dbl WA1440
- DCAS County Champs
- DCAS Autumn Gold
- DCAS Field Champs
- DCAS Clout Champs
- b) The GWAS Junior Intercounties Tournament (Only Team Members shooting).

All claims for reimbursement and grants must be rendered within 2 months from the date of the shoot/expenditure to be considered for payment.
